Guidelines and Procedures

LEGACY CAMP

Thank you for choosing THE VISION as the location for your event. In order to be good stewards of this property, we ask that you review the following guidelines with your group:

1. Power

- Air conditioning is available in the kitchen, bunkhouses, and cabin. The thermostats are set at a steady temperature to make your stay comfortable. Please contact a VISION staff member if you need assistance with these units.
- Please only use the hair dryers provided. Others may trip the breakers.
- Please turn off lights when not in use.
- Please keep doors closed at all times to maintain temperatures inside.

2. Bathroom and Septic Usage

- ALL paper products must go in the trash cans as our septic system cannot handle paper waste.
- Please keep your showers short to insure hot water for everyone.

3. Parking

- Please park vehicles in the designated gravel lots.
- The lower bunkhouse parking allows for only 2 vehicles.

4. Trash/Waste Management

- As trash receptacles fill, tie the bags closed and place them outside the building. A staff member will come to retrieve them daily.
- Please place new trash bags in all receptacles. Additional liners will be made available.

5. Safety

- All minors should be supervised by an adult at all times.
- All youth groups (18 and under) are required to have adult counselors (21 or older) within a ratio of 1 female counselor for every 10 girls and 1 male counselor for every 10 boys.
- No lifeguards are on duty. Swim at your own risk. A Group Leader must be present for all swimming/boating/fishing activities. A VISION staff member will let you know if the pond is suitable for swimming or water activities during your stay. See pool rules for more details.
- No climbing in the rafters at the bunkhouse.
- Some areas of the camp are still under construction. Do not approach any construction equipment and/or sites.
- Possession and use of fireworks, firearms, and similar equipment are not permitted without prior permission from Vision Ministries for an organized activity. All safety rules must be followed.
- Ropes Course and Tomahawk Range equipment are only to be used under the supervision of a Vision Ministries staff member.

6. Behavior

- Profanity and alcoholic beverages are not permitted on campus. Smoking inside buildings is not permitted and is discouraged on campus. Use or possession of alcoholic beverages or illicit drugs will result in guest(s) removal.
- Observe appropriate dress standards at all times. Modest swimsuits only.
- Please report any damages immediately. Guests are financially responsible for damages to property and excessive cleaning costs.
- Guests are personally responsible for securing and protecting valuables while on THE VISION campus.
